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



Stimulating green skills market


RisiAlbania has been working since early 2023 to stimulate a market for green skills training



Challenges:

- Lack of awareness and understanding of the value of green skills
- Limited availability of job opportunities that require green skills

Entry points for green skills



Green skills for green jobs

RisiAlbania supported:

 Private sector to introduce standards for accessing high value markets, embedded green skills and behaviour change (Global GAP, CTST, GRASP)

Training Providers

- to raise awareness among businesses and youth on green skills
- to green exiting curricula (tourism sector)
 - assessing training needs,
 - capacitating the instructors,
 - designing tailored training programs.
