

Why green skills matter


- Green transition is reshaping labour markets
 - Job losses and reallocation
 - Job creation
 - Job transformation
- Vulnerable groups risk being left behind






What are green skills?

Broad set of technical and transversal skills that are driven by, or contribute to, the green transition and that they are built on a foundation of appropriate values and attitudes

How to embed green skills? VSD typology entry points





Design for Greater Efficiency in Ghana, South Africa, Indonesia, Peru and Colombia


How to embed green skills? VET delivery entry points

Closing remarks

- Context specific: no one-size-fits-all approach
- Gender & social inclusion gaps: barriers persist
- Resource constraints: requires a pragmatic approach
- Green skills are key for sustainable, inclusive development
- VSD can be a driver, not just a responder
- Multiple entry points: systemic and programmatic
